Requirements to become a Registered SACGA Gas Practitioner (Excluding Design)

To become an authorized SACGA Gas Practitioner (excluding Design), your registration is based upon the submission of Technical & Practical Qualifications and proof of Experience in the respective gas industry for the gases and work scopes being applied for.

The Applicant will need to:

- Meet the Pre-entry requirements as detailed on the application form.
- The application form can be found on either www.saqccgas.co.za or www.sacga.za.org
- Submit detailed Portfolio of Evidence (PoE) technical and practical with the application form. Refer to Supporting Documentation in the application form.
- Provide a copy of a Digital CoC signed off by a Mentor (mandatory) for each of the last 5 chronological gas projects for each gas system/scope of work applied for with images (if possible). Refer to Supporting Documentation in the application form.
- The Mentor shall be a SAQCC Registered Gas Practitioner who is registered for the gas/s and the scope of work you wish to be registered for. The mentor shall complete a 'Mentor Declaration Form' which shall be sent to the SACGA office for registration. This form shall be signed by both the Mentor and the applicant. Mentorship shall not commence prior to receipt of the form at the offices of the SACGA.
- After satisfying himself/herself that the Applicant has fulfilled all the requirements to be registered as a Gas Practitioner, the Mentor shall review and sign the application form and provide a completed "Final Mentor Declaration Form" deeming the applicant competent for the gas/s and scope of work being applied for. The GP applicant shall attach this form to his/her New Gas Practitioner application documentation.
- After satisfying himself/herself that the Applicant has fulfilled all the requirements to be registered as a Gas Practitioner, your Line Manager / Supervisor shall review and sign the application form.
- All the required information as per sections 2 to 5 in the application form shall be included with the completed application form.
- Proof of attendance (SACGA Certificate of Attendance) at the applicable SACGA training sessions covering SANS 10260-1, Industrial gas pipeline installations, SANS 10260-3 Acetylene industrial gas pipeline installations and SANS 7396-1 for medical gas pipeline installations. For Acetylene and Medical applications prior attendance at the SANS 10260-1 training is a prerequisite.
- Your competence will be assessed by the SACGA Gas Practitioner Registration Working Group based upon the portfolio of evidence supplied with the application. If found to be satisfactory a Gas Practitioner licence will be issued.
